

Hi Triallers –

Due to the new rules set out by MSUK we have had to alter the way Trials events are held with SCOR.

General ways of working -

- Please **do not attend** if you've had COVID symptoms or come into contact with someone with symptoms in the previous 14 days. If you develop symptoms on the day please make this known to an official.
- All event documents for all attendees must be received via email the day before the event at the latest (See below) – **without this in my inbox on the Saturday you cannot enter the site on the Sunday morning.**
- Currently anyone not competing must sign on as an official – This is limited to close family only, please don't invite purely spectators.
- Payment (still £30) must be sent to (SC 11-01-14, Acc 11769367) before the start of the day. No cash on the day.
- A running order will continue.
- Sharing vehicles is permitted, but contact surfaces must be wiped with your own Dettol wipes in between drivers.
- Passengers are only permitted from the same household.
- The 1m+ socially distance rules must be adhered to at all times.
- If recovery means you cannot socially distance, gloves and a mask must be worn before recovery.
- **All attendees must bring their own bottle of hand sanitiser to site.**
- We shall not be using cards, scores are to be noted down as they occur by an official.
